## Introduction


I am an Advocate and Solicitor qualified since 1977. I now practice as an Accredited Civil and Commercial Mediation and trained Family Lawyer Mediator and Wills expert with over 30 years experience of Property and Conveyancing as a Solicitor, mainly in Central London.

I was also called to the Bar in Singapore and practised in the High Court as an Advocate and Solicitor 1994-1997. I have conducted several High Court trials, some of which are reported in the Singapore Law reports.

In 2011, I decided to re-train as a Family law specialist. I have been divorced twice and as a father of 3 children have experienced the consequences of the hostile adversarial system we have here, in England and Singapore. I decided in 2012 to start my own practice being Mortlake Law & Mediation specialising in Mediation, Family law, Wills and Lasting Powers of Attorney. I now have a comprehensive family law and mediation practice, specialising in divorce, financial remedy applications, applications regarding the property of non-married couples and private Children law issues.

I have a range of skills, knowledge and experience which I use to maximise my clients' own ability to reach agreement. I have a Law degree and graduated in England as a Solicitor. I have in recent years completed open University modules on Social Sciences and Psychology to help my legal work and to assist my clients. In 2012 I passed a level 2 course on Counselling. 

## Living together

If your relationship ends, you need to be sure of your rights. Whatever your situation, professional legal advice can make sure that your interests are protected. If your separation affects your home, your savings or even your children's future, I will work to help you reach a fair settlement. If your relationship breaks down and you were not married or had not registered a civil partnership the legal issues you face may be complex.



This is because there is no act of Parliament which specifically governs the law for people who have lived together and so the remedies are cobbled together in many areas of the law. I have a wealth of experience in advising individuals on the breakdown of these relationships. I will work with you to offer creative strategies to ameliorate the worst of the impacts. People who live together do not automatically inherit on the death of their partner. In the absence of a will, this may cause real difficulties.

I provide specialist advice and representation in the circumstances. I use the latest technology to assist my clients and offer a fast and effective service. The lack of a family focused legal framework for people who have lived together means that many couples prefer to find solutions in mediation. I can provide the expert help that many couples need to find their own solutions. Similar issues apply if disputes arise over family property which is shared with wider family members or with friends. Inheritance disputes may also arise these circumstances. I will work with you to reach a fair settlement in these cases.

## Parenting issues

Children are especially vulnerable to the effects of divorce and separation. I can provide expert advice on contact (access) and joint parenting arrangements and a range of other concerns, drawing on strong relationships that I have with other professionals, where appropriate. I can introduce you to a specialist independent counsellors to help your family come to terms with the emotional issues involved to help you keep the impact to a minimum, using specialist support. I can advise you on appropriate financial provision for your children.

I will work together with you to put in place the best possible arrangements for the long-term benefit of you and your children. ## **Relationship agreements**

Relationship agreements (often referred to as pre marriage, prenuptial, pre-civil partnership agreements or cohabitation contracts) can give you peace of mind. A mediator, acting as a neutral third party to assist separating couples to create and develop their own solutions to child, relationship and financial issues.






